*33 "No one lights a lamp and puts it

its stand, so that those who come in

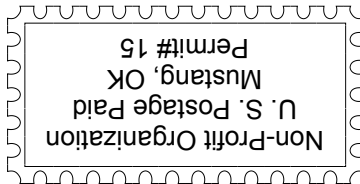
