

Summer Camp FAQs

WHICH GRADE GOES WHERE?

Summer Camp attendance is determined by the grade a student will be in for the 2013-2014 school year. A major goal of camp is to provide opportunity for the age appropriate ministry of the coming year to begin their journey together.

WHAT HAPPENED TO PRETEEN CAMP?

After an extensive process of research and meeting with several focus groups and other churches, we have decided to make some changes beginning June 2013 with grades based on the 2013-2014 school year.

6th Grade Students will make a gradual transition into the 7th & 8th grade programming. In June, they will start this transition and will be fully integrated into the new Middle School programming by January 2014.

4th and 5th Grade Students will be combined and meet in what is currently known as the Preteen Room.

Because of these changes, we are making a move to have a 4th & 5th Grade Camp, July 29-31 and Middle School Camp for 6th-8th Grade, July 8-11. Many elements of Middle School Camp will run so that 6th Grade will be having their own unique experiences from 7th & 8th Grade.

WHAT IS THE SPIRITUAL VALUE?

Summer Camp may simply look like 3-5 days of all fun and games. Very far from the case. EVERYTHING we do is planned to give students an opportunity to connect with the Living God. Students will be specifically encouraged and challenged in their faith through the following avenues:

Personal TAWG (Time Alone With God): Every morning students will take ample time to get into the Word, pray, and enjoy God's beautiful creation.

Celebration Times: In morning and night sessions, students will pull together for a time of worship, teaching, and challenge from God's Word.

Cabin Groups: Each night, students will meet with the leader and students in their cabin for a time of sharing, prayer, and accountability.

WHAT KIND OF STAFFING WILL BE PRESENT?

Each camp will be more than adequately staffed with adult leaders.

WHAT ARE WE PAYING FOR?

The Summer Camp costs cover housing & facility rentals, meals, activities (amusement parks, etc) and various programming elements.

PLEASE NOTE: Campers will need to bring \$\$ for two meals.

ONCE REGISTERED, WHAT DO WE DO?

Parents can expect a letter 10 days prior to departure with a schedule, packing list, emergency contact numbers and other important info.
