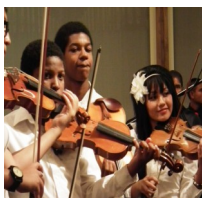
- Rhapsody of Love Benefit Concert features Elevation Orchestra. Headliner: Michael Bearden
