

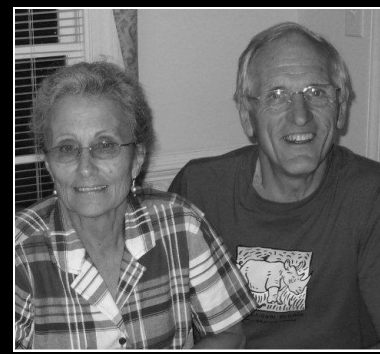
Reaching...

Ministry Focus:

In 2005, God gave *MSI* the opportunity to build and operate a medical mission in Southern Sudan. In October 2006, the Akot Medical Mission opened its doors to patients. Today, the present medical staff sees over 100 patients daily. The Mission is a beacon of light among the lost and hurting Dinka people. It is an instrument God can and will use to share the Gospel, not only among patients, but in the surrounding villages across South Sudan. The fact that 10% of children do not live to see their 5th birthday and infant mortality rate is over 15%, is something God would not allow *MSI* to ignore. It is their desire to make a dent in those and other awful statistics as the hospital staff, doctors, nurses and ministers share their medical and spiritual experience to help lower this mortality rate and raise the "eternal life" rate. **John and Jennifer** are God's people for this time and life at the mission and are suited for this task at hand because of their years of experience and service in Kenya. *MSI* feels that their presence, skills, management and operational skills and knowledge of how things should work, loving manner to the staff and Dinka people, as what God will use to bring Him Glory among the Dinka.
