A Life Under Construction #3: Discipleship: Why? How? Now.

WHY?

- 1. The cry of the human heart:
 - To be known completely
 - To be loved completely
- 2. Jesus met the heart cry in His disciples' lives. The <u>closeness</u> of their <u>relationship</u> was as important as His <u>teaching</u>.
- Jesus taught the disciples to pray, "<u>Our Father".</u> (Matt 6:9)
 - Jesus washed his disciples' feet. (John 13)
- 3. God's Kingdom is not about methods, but about people.

HOW?

As the disciple, I need to be <u>humble</u>

As a discipler, I am to...

- Be confidential.
- <u>Teach</u> him/her how to <u>obey</u> Christ based on God's word.
- I am to pray for him/her
- Know and love.

<u>JESUS</u> is the ultimate disciple-maker, and the aim of discipleship is to become more like <u>Christ</u>.

- 1. 'The cry of the human heart is to be known completely and loved completely.' Discuss.
- 2. Have you ever had a time when you found it hard to obey a command of Christ?
- 3. Jesus commands His disciples to baptise others and teach His commands in the context of a close relationship. Do you see this type of relationship in your life? Why /why not?
- 4. 'A sermon just isn't enough!' Discuss.
- 5. Share your roadblocks on this journey of discipleship and ask someone to pray with you.
