Scripture Reading Exodus 30: 1-3 (KJV):

“Then make another altar of acacia wood for burning incense. Make it 18 inches square and 36 inches high, with horns at the corners carved from the same piece of wood as the altar itself. Overlay the top, sides, and horns of the altar with pure gold, and run a gold molding around the entire altar.”





Scripture Reading (KJV):

- Hebrews 9: 1 - 3. “That first covenant between God and Israel had regulations for worship and a place of worship here on earth.
- 2 There were two rooms in that Tabernacle. In the first room were a lampstand, a table, and sacred loaves of bread on the table. This room was called the Holy Place.
- 3 Then there was a curtain, and behind the curtain was the second room called the Most Holy Place.

The Gate of Entry

- The Gate is the Approach into the Tabernacle. (Exodus 27: 16).
- This was the only entrance to the Court (John 14: 6)

- I Pet 2: 9

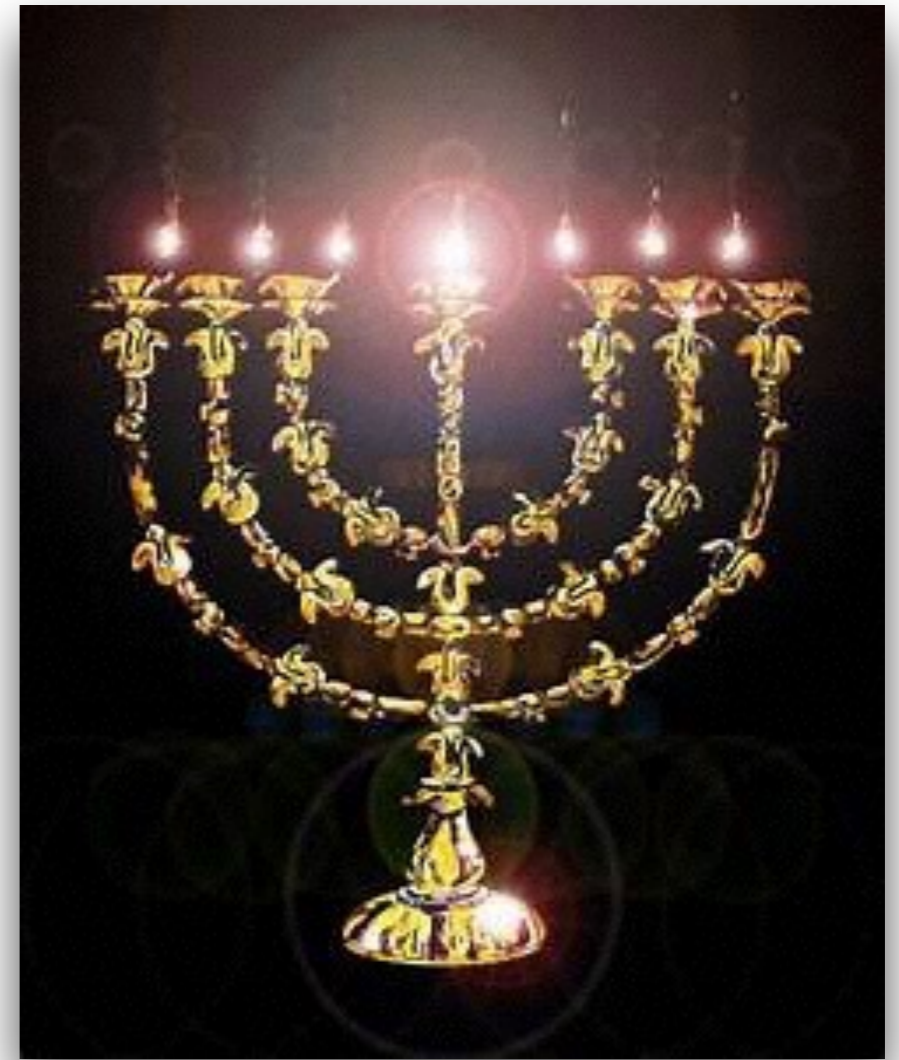

The Holy Place “The Realm of Revelation”

- **Lampstand:** represents the Church (Rev 1: 20)
- **The Light or Fire** represents the revelation of the Holy Spirit.
- Exodus 25: 31; 37.³¹ And thou shalt make a candlestick of pure gold: of beaten work shall the candlestick be made: his shaft, and his branches, his bowls, his knops, and his flowers, shall be of the same. And thou shalt make the seven lamps thereof: and they shall light the lamps thereof, **that they may give light over against it.**
