Destiny-Walkers – Fulfilling Destiny

Judges 7:9-24/ 1Corinthians 12:18



Defining Destiny

Stepping into a place in time predetermined by God where I will have the greatest impact on the destiny of others



Defining a Destiny Walker

A person or people group "**DETERMINED**" to walk in the purposes predetermined for them with the focus on doing the will of God while impacting the destiny of others



Seasons are purposed by God as 'opportune time' to implement 'change'

Seasons – signify an appointed or appropriated (suitable) time for something usually to change



NEW ADJUSTMENTS REQURE NEW PERSPECTIVE



Stepping into Destiny Requires:

Stripping – Strips away personal comforts

Stretching - Stretches faith

Strengthening – Strengthens Insecurities/uncertainties



Gideon is given 300 hand-picked people by GOD whose destinies are tied to His!

- 1Cor 12:18(NKJV/ISV)
- But now God has set the members, each one of them, in the body just as He pleased.
- But now God has arranged the parts, every one of them, in the body according to his plan



 In order for the 300 to achieve victory with Gideon (leader) they must be willing to:

• **Listen** – Jas 1:22-25

• **Submit** – Heb 13:17

• **Obey** – Josh 1:16

• **Follow** – Ru 1:16



- Gideon applies the following:
- Vision Where they were going/What was their task
- Mission How they were going to accomplish their task
- **Purpose** He showed them they were no longer slaves but warriors
- Season He helps to shift them into the new season of freedom
- Challenge Challenged them to step into their destiny
- Opportunity He takes advantage of the enemy's confusion & attacks
- Destiny Gideon and the 300 go to the other tribes of Israel and invite them to participate in routing the enemy, thus IMPACTING THEIR DESTINY AS WELL!
