A.Potential Defined

- 1. Existing and ready for action, but not active.
- 2. Capable of being but not yet in existence; latent.
- 3. The inherent (*innate*) ability or capacity for growth, development, or coming into being.
- 4. Potential is the seed that houses the capability to discover the real you!



Philosophy of Aristotle

According to Aristotle, a change must occur in something for its potentiality to become an actuality. The potentiality of something includes its capability to change, or its capability to **be** changed, or both and normally requires a stimulus (stressors, HALT), whether external or internal, that lead towards development. Aristole explains this through the basic dynamics of potentiality and actuality



A. Define Purpose

 Simply, the reason for which anything is created or exists

1. Chronos:

A "Measure of Time"

1. Kairos:

- a. A time when conditions are right for the accomplishment of a crucial or decisive action:
- b. The opportune and decisive moment.
- c. In the New Testament, *kairos* means "*the appointed time in the purpose of God*"; the time when God acts

A. 7 Directives for the Believer of Purpose

Serve Others

Jn. 13:1-17; Mk. 10:41-45

So when He had washed their feet, taken His garments, and sat down again, He said to them, "Do you know what I have done to you? You call Me Teacher and Lord, and you say well, for so I am. If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet. For I have given you an example, that you should do as I have done to you. Most assuredly, I say to you, a servant is not greater than his master; nor is he who is sent greater than he who sent him.

For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."
