- Made of pure gold w/ 2 Cherubim at each end (divine)

• It Sits atop the Ark of Covenant

What is Mercy?

The Prominent concept of mercy is - the compassionate disposition to forgive an offender or adversary and to help or spare him in his sorry plight. Ps 51:1-2



Mercy is Compassion in Action

God is normally moved or filled with "Compassion"

Mercy becomes Compassion in Action or rather merciful action.



Mercy cannot be Earned; But is Bestowed on someone

- Even before they had been born or had done anything good or bad (so that God's purpose of election might continue, ¹² not by works but by his call) she was told, "The elder shall serve the younger." ¹³ As it is written, "I have loved Jacob, but I have hated Esau." ¹⁴ What then are we to say? Is there injustice on God's part? By no means! ¹⁵ For he says to Moses, "I will have mercy on whom I have mercy, and I will have compassion on whom I have compassion." ¹⁶ So it depends not on human will or exertion, but on God who shows mercy.
