Course Descriptions

Art

Art is taught by Mrs. Kenitzer who has been a part of NSCA for over 16 years. Students will have the opportunity to experience many different types of art, from ceramics to printmaking and so much more. There is never a boring day in this class!

Math

Saxon math is offered for those who would like to round out their academic requirements. 6th grade studies Math 7/6, 7th grade studies Algebra ½ (similar to Pre-Algebra), and 8th grade studies Algebra 1. Math is an extremely beneficial class to take, but parents and students should note that instruction will also need to be done at home. While a good quantity (and quality) of instruction will happen at school, there is no way to cover everything or give all the help needed in two days per week; however, many students greatly benefit from the in-class instruction and are able to test out of high school Algebra I upon graduation from NSCA.

Spanish

NSCA offers Spanish I, Spanish II, and Spanish III. Students are required to complete the previous course before enrolling in the next. Our Spanish course is designed to allow students to test out of a minimum of high school Spanish I upon completion of NSCA's Spanish III. This is a fast-paced but extremely fun and beneficial class taught by veteran teacher Mrs. Weaver.

Study Hall

Study Hall is available to those students wishing to have time on-site to work on homework or get a little extra help.

Yearbook (8th grade ONLY and by approval)

Students will partner with a teacher sponsor to help in certain aspects of our yearbook design, administration, and picture-taking. This class is limited to four (4) students.

Tuition Agreement

New Song Christian Academy has a number of ongoing expenses such as faculty and administrative salaries and supplies. In order to maintain these services throughout the school year, it is essential that NSCA's annual income from tuition and fees be consistent based on people's commitment to the program. Because of this, we have established the following policies:

- Students registering before June 15 must pay the New Student Application and Registration fees at the time of registration.
- Supply Fees may be paid between the time of registration and June 15. Any fees not paid by June 15 will be automatically drafted from your account on June 15.
- Students registering after June 15 must pay New Student Application, Registration, and Supply fees at the time of registration in order to be enrolled.

Mid-Year Enrollment

- Students enrolling in August, September and October:
 - Pay full Supply Fees, which are due at the time of registration
 - Pay the full yearly Tuition amount distributed evenly over the months remaining until the end of the school year

Fee

Students registering before June 15 must pay the New Student Application and Registration fees at the time of registration.

Supply Fees may be paid between the time of registration and June 15. Any fees not paid by June 15 will be automatically drafted from your account on June 15.

Students registering after June 15 must pay New Student Application, Registration, and Supply fees at the time of registration in order to be enrolled.

Mid-Year Enrollment

Students enrolling in August, September and October:

- Pay full Supply Fees, which are due at the time of registration
- Pay the full yearly Tuition amount distributed evenly over the months remaining until the end of the school year

Students enrolling in November and December:

- Pay full Supply Fees, which are due at the time of registration
- Pay prorated yearly Tuition amount distributed evenly over the months remaining until the end of the school year

Students enrolling after Christmas Break:

- Pay half Supply Fees, which are due at the time of registration
- Pay prorated yearly Tuition amount distributed evenly over the months remaining until the end of the school year

Tuition Payments

Automatic Bank Draft (ACH Debit) is required for monthly tuition payments. Drafts will be processed on your choice of either the 1st or 15th of each month (August through May). Any bank fees incurred by NSCA for ACH Debits returned as unpaid will be assessed to your customer account.

If your ACH Debit is returned as unpaid, NSCA will re-debit your account for the tuition plus bank fee within three business days after receiving the return notice.

Student Early Withdrawal

If a student withdraws before the NSCA school year begins, school fees already paid (Application, Registration, Supply and Tuition) are non-refundable.

If a student withdraws after the NSCA school year has begun but before October 31, 75% of the remainder of the first semester (August - December) tuition will be due.

If student withdraws after October 31, 75% of the remainder of the full year Tuition (August-May) tuition will be due.

Pre-paid Tuition Refunds

If a student withdraws before August 1, 75% of pre-paid tuition is refundable.

If a student withdraws between August 2 and beginning of the NSCA school year, 50% of pre-paid tuition is refundable.

If a student withdraws after the NSCA school year begins, pre-paid tuition is non-refundable.
