FEES: \$25 Application Fee per Child

\$190 per week includes:

- Full Day Program, weekly swimming at Aquatic Center, weekly on-site swimming, two daily snacks & lunch
- Weekly Field trips, Projects and Guest Speakers
 - Some of these activities may be scheduled for small additional costs (normally <\$5).
 Whenever possible we arrange for activities that incur no additional cost!
- A \$15 late fee will be assessed for all payments submitted after 10:00 AM Monday morning
- A \$15 late fee will be assessed for every portion of a quarter hour students are picked up after 5:30 PM each evening

REGISTRATION: Register at Next Generation School 2521 Galen Drive, Champaign. To ensure a place for your child in our Summer Camp Program we recommend that you register for the specific weeks you desire no later than Monday, May 4. Late Registrations will be accepted if space is available at the discretion of the Program Director.

LOCATION: All Summer Camp participants will be in the main NGS School Building at 2521 Galen Drive in Champaign.

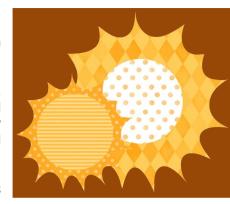
WHAT TO WEAR: Participants should wear comfortable clothing and gym shoes each day. (NO SANDALS)

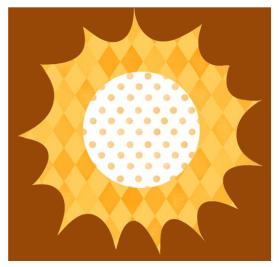
