



**Connect Group Questions**  
**Fallen Giants: The Wisest Idiot**

(1 Kings 11:1-6)

**1.** Read how Solomon was proclaimed King in 1 Kings 1:28-30. What does this teach you about the type of person God uses for his service and what does that mean for you?

**2.** This week read Song of Songs/Solomon (don't worry you won't get bored). What do you notice about Solomon and his wife? What do you think drove Solomon to where he is in 1 Kings 11:3?

**3.** Our passage says "they [1,000 foreign women], turned his [Solomon's] heart to worship other gods." Why do you think Solomon allowed these cultures to influence him so dramatically in spite of his supernatural wisdom?

**4.** This week we compared some things our culture values to that of Christ-centered values. Which of these stuck out to you the most? Do you struggle in valuing any of these (or others) over what the Bible says at times?

**5.** Read Romans 12:1-2. As a follower of Christ, what is the most difficult spiritual application (an adjustment you had to make) you have encountered that is "counter-cultural"?
