GOALS:

Read 1 Corinthians 14:7-11

- Do you understand why the Corinthians passage is a good introduction to this series/topic? How would you paraphrase this passage?

Read Genesis 1; 2:15-17; 3:1-5, 8-13

- Where in Genesis 1 do you find evidence of the sub points (A-D) from the sermon outline, that language is a divine attribute (part 1 of outline)?
- Have you ever said something innocently to someone that was completely misunderstood? Please share with the group. Are these good passages for this subject matter? Why or why not?
- What are some safeguards that we can use to avoid the same mistakes that Adam and Eve made?
- Based on the conversation in this study, what other words in Scripture do we need to clarify?
