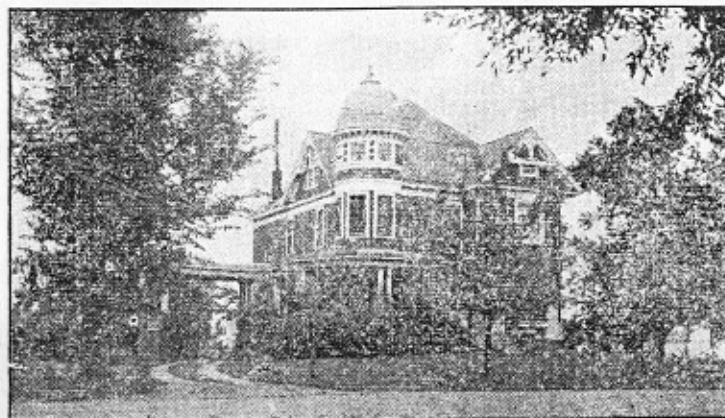

Dakota Bible College

For nearly four years some of us who know and love this great Central Northern part of the U.S.A. have talked and dreamed and prayed about the planting of a Bible College to serve this neglected mission area. Finally the Lord has opened the way for our dreams and hopes to become a reality. On Sept. 22, 1942, Dakota Bible College began its teaching work at Arlington.

About thirty to forty-five years ago G. W. Elliott and others planted many flourishing Churches of Christ in the Dakotas. Some have died because of a shortage of Ministers, but there are about twenty-two Churches of Christ now in these two States. Many outside Ministers are reluctant to move to the Dakotas, not knowing that these two States are really far better than the impression that people in other states have received. Dakota Bible College plans to train up many Christian workers right in this area, and put them to work reviving some of these dead churches, and planting new ones. Last year we had only four students, but these four accomplished grand things. Already we have prospects of four or five times that many for the 1943-44 school year. We hope soon to help relieve the Minister shortage in the Dakotas, Nebraska, Wyoming, and Montana, as well as more distant points.

After much consultation with those who know this whole territory it was decided to leave the Bible College in Arlington for some time to come. Therefore, on July 15, 1943, the College purchased in Arlington a very large beautiful eleven room house and grounds for \$3,000.00. This is to be used as Administration Building, and offices, class rooms, and living quarters for some of the teaching force and students. All who know this property consider it a wonderful buy. Arlington is located in the very heart of the eastern prosperous section of So. Dak. Its immediate field for preaching points will be the approximate one half million people who live in the eastern end of the State. Arlington is about half way between the Nebraska and North Dakota lines. Arlington is on the Chicago North Western R. R. that runs from Chicago to Rapid City. It is on the Great Northern R. R. that runs from Sioux Falls to Watertown. It is on Federal Highway number 14 that runs east and west, and is on the Federal Canada to Mexico Highway number 81.

Those who are leading and teaching in Dakota Bible College believe the Bible to be the Infallible Word of The Living God. We believe that God said what He meant and meant what He said. Our passion is to train Christian workers so that they will be consecrated, prayerful, sacrificing, effective, diligent soul winners for Christ and Gospel preachers. The training of the students will not be in class room work alone, but will

also include considerable actual experience and service, such as teaching, preaching, evangelism, soul winning, and conducting Gospel services of various kinds. The teachers will include W. E. Stram, Mr. and Mrs. Harry Carter as part time instructors, one or two other full time Bible teachers who will be announced soon, a very accomplished local piano teacher, and possibly other teachers who are now being considered.

The College is open to all who love the Lord Jesus, are eager to do His Will, and eager to let their lives count in Christian service. The College offers both a two year Christian Worker's Course, leading to a Certificate, and a regular four year Bible College Course, leading to a Diploma.

To the first year students we will offer New Testament Exegesis, Old Testament History, Evangelism, Public Speaking, Homiletics, Bible Study by Books, Youth Evangelism, English, Music, and possibly other subjects. We expect to offer alternately, this year and next, the following advanced subjects, with possibly others added, too:—Second and Third Year New Testament Exegesis, second year Old Testament History, Biblical and Christian Evidences, Biblical and Christian Doctrine, advanced Homiletics, Bible Study by Books, Church History, Restoration History, Archaeology, Comparative Religions, Combatting False Doctrines, Teacher Training, Hermeneutics, Typology, Church Music, Evangelistic Singing, Bible Prophecy, Pastoral Theology, Public Speaking, and vocal and instrumental music.

Expenses of attending Dakota Bible College will be very nominal. The regular tuition is \$50.00 per year. Books will average from six to fifteen dollars for each student for the year. Board and heated room will cost about \$190.00 for nine months. Light house-keeping rooms and apartments are available for those who desire them. Considerable part-time work is available. Most of the classes are held in the mornings so as to leave the students free for afternoon work or study. No classes are held on Mondays or Saturdays.

Registration of students is to be on Mon., Sept. 20, and classes are to begin on the 21st. If students can arrive a little in advance of registration date it will help them to get settled, and secure work, if desired, before school actually starts.

Except for money received from tuitions Dakota Bible College is being financed entirely by gifts and offerings from churches and individuals. Anyone desiring to help the School may send gifts to W.
