<u>First our established plants need continued prayers</u>, at Spearfish, SD, Matt Branum and his family has led Northpoint Christian Church for 13 years. For 9 years, Adam Coop and family still leads the way for Whitewater Christian Church in Laramie, Derek Olsen and family heads up Revive Christian Church in Bismarck, ND, for the last 5 years, and Ryan Charest and family are in their third year at Real Life Christian Church in Sheridan, WY.

Pray for churches we helped start; special prayers for Carl Smith and his family as they lead Gateway Community Church in Mountain Home, WY. Continue to pray for a church body we helped plant in Boise, ID as they have merged with another church a few years back and sadly, please send prayers to the family of Ed Taylor who we helped plant Quest Church in the Chicago area as I just learned he died of a heart attack following double knee surgery last fall. The church has since closed.

<u>Pray for new churches that are in various stages of startup</u>. Keep Drew Hanson and family as they work to launch Rally Point Christian Church in Sioux City, IA, Willie Tryon and family as they work toward moving to Hastings, NE in June. Pray for a soon-to-be announced plant in Bozeman, MT. Continue prayers for the planter search for Aberdeen, SD.
