What are the dates? February 15-22, July 19-26, and October 11-18.

What do we do? God has orchestrated an incredible turn of events that have led to us partnering with a local man to plant a church, Faith Baptist Church, in Darbonne, Haiti. Some days we teach the leaders and members of that church. Other days we simply encourage. Other days we invite locals to attend special services. Our work is varied and fluid. Each day brings a new challenge and opportunity.

What skills and talents do I need? If you are filled with the Holy Spirit, you have what you need. Your talents can and will be used to glorify God and bless the Haitian people, regardless of what they are.

Am I or is the family member I want send in danger? While we can never guarantee safety, Haiti is no more dangerous than your average city. Those who have already been there generally say they would feel completely comfortable sending their children.

What is the cost? Cost will vary by how you are able to travel. Often, if we fly out Thursday night, rather than Friday morning, and stay at a hotel in Miami we can save around \$400. The trip will range from \$1,100 to \$1,600.

What can I expect? Expect hot, humid conditions and lots of walking. Expect to have your heart broken and blessed at the same time. Expect to take cold showers. Expect the electricity to be shaky at best. Expect to get car sick...not everyone can ride in the front seat. Expect a lot of noise all the time. Expect God to use you in a HUGE way!
