Wellhouse



The WellHouse is a faith-based and Christ-centered nonprofit organization offering immediate shelter and transitional housing to women who have been trafficked, are prostituting, or otherwise sexually exploited. Wellhouse has no prerequisites or requirements, other than being a victim of sexual exploitation. Food, clothing, spiritual guidance, Christian counseling, and other necessities are provided, along with assisting with referrals for substance abuse treatment, if needed. Life skills classes, GED preparation, and other enrichment services are part of the experience to help these women become self-sufficient and give them a sense of self-worth. The goal is for women to go on to live full and productive lives. WellHouse welcomes all women who have been sexually exploited and/or a victim of human trafficking. Regardless of race, color, creed, or religion, women in pain can be assured they will find love and acceptance in the arms of the WellHouse.

How can you be involved?

- One-on-one mentorship for women looking to rebuild their lives
- Lead bible study classes
- Offer personal support by volunteering as a house leader
