OFFICER TEAM

Wesley is a student-empowered and student-led ministry. Our leadership team is comprised of student officers and interns who envision, plan, and facilitate ministry programs. Student leaders attend a weekly team meeting and take shifts providing hospitality to peers in our space throughout each week. Students are also encouraged to pursue leadership opportunities in local churches and organizations.



OUR PROGRAMS

Our programming includes worship, bible study, free weekly lunch and dinner, retreats and leadership conferences, mission trips and local volunteering, fellowship events at the center of campus, and an internship program for students exploring a call to ministry.

WEEKLY EVENTS

Wesley Wednesday

We meet weekly on Wednesday nights at 7pm to enjoy a free meal, fellowship, worship, and to engage in discussion about faith and life. We often host guest speakers to facilitate conversations about faith, spirituality, and social justice.

Bible Study

We host a weekly bible study for students to study passages for one hour through an inclusive lens.

Worship & Lunch

Students are encouraged to participate in a local church. On Sundays, we provide rides from the UT Dallas campus to Arapaho United Methodist Church. After worship we eat free lunch together, often provided by church volunteers.

FAIL RETREAT








EMPOWERED TO LEAD


