Greetings!

A number of years ago **Henry Blackaby** wrote a study entitled "**Experiencing God**". It's a wonderful study and one that has been tremendously used of God. In fact, many of you probably benefited personally from this insightful work. A fundamental teaching of Blackaby's is that we should look to see where God is at work and then join Him there. This understanding has impacted a huge number of people and helped move them to greater obedience.

Certainly God has been at work among us since he breathed life into Adam. Yet, there is much to be done. **Erwin McManus** suggests that there may be another question that needs to be asked in addition to "*What is God doing?*" That is, "*What is God dreaming?*" Is there something God wants to do and He is waiting for someone, like you, to volunteer?

What is it about our prayer life that we seem to hear "no" more readily than "yes"? Many times when we claim we're waiting on God, He may be waiting on us. Yes, it's true that Jesus instructed his disciples to wait in the Upper Room until they received the Holy Spirit. But then He instructed them that once they received God's Spirit, they were to move out and change the world. The book of Acts clearly describes a people on the move with God. They lived their lives fueled by the divine "yes". They lived with a sense of destiny, a confidence that nothing could stop them from accomplishing God's purpose. We, too, have received the Spirit of God and are expected to move forward with confidence because God is with us.

We were each put on this earth to make a contribution. We weren't created just to consume resources. God designed us to make a difference in this world! As **Rick Warren** says, "*A saved heart is one that wants to serve.*" We are not saved *by* service, but we are saved *for* service. For believers, service is not optional. It's not something to be added onto our schedules if we can spare the time. It is the heart of the Christian life. Spiritual growth is not an end in itself. We grow up in order to give out. The **Apostle Paul** said, "*For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works...*" (Eph. 2:10). As we move forward, where does God want to use you?
