Greetings from Tommy!

When Benjamin was only seven months old, he and I unexpectedly awoke early one morning. For some strange reason, we both voluntarily stirred several precious moments before Hannah woke up. He wasn't crying and I wasn't reluctantly responding to some middle-of-the-night tantrum. We were voluntarily awake and both of us were happy to greet the day.

I brought him into the living room where we sat on the floor. I read my Bible as he gleefully rolled around on the carpet like little boys do. At some point I scooped him up and read to him from where I'd been reading, Isaiah 43. As I did, I replaced the names "Israel" and "Jacob" with his, and felt a calming presence as I said these words aloud:

"But now, this is what the LORD says—
He who created you, Jacob,
He who formed you, Israel:
'Do not fear, for I have redeemed you;
I have summoned you by name; you are Mine.
When you pass through the waters,
I will be with you;
and when you pass through the rivers,
they will not sweep over you.
When you walk through the fire,
you will not be burned;
the flames will not set you ablaze.
For I am the LORD your God,
the Holy One of Israel, your Savior;
...You are precious and honored in My sight,

and... I love you..."



The Easter event we just celebrated declares this passage to be true. And personal. It's the announcement that God is wildly passionate about you, that He recklessly pursues you, and that no matter what you're going through, He is infinitely *for* you.

So try it. Read this passage aloud, but insert your own name. Feel His presence. And take comfort in the fact that, if you know Jesus Christ, you are His. And no matter what comes your way, you can find refuge in Him.
