

PASTOR'S PARAGRAPHS

A HEADLINE IN THE MAY 9, 2013 WS JOURNAL READ:

"We're in the midst of a raucous invasion"

The headline was in reference to the year of the Cicada. As you know and can hear daily right now, the Cicadas have returned for their every 17th year appearance. According to the article, there are actually billions of them in gardens and yards all along the East Coast of the US. They may dig in your yard or make mud chimneys as they tunnel through. For 17 years they lived underground and now they are emerging this spring. They will sing and mate and lay eggs and the new cicadas then will burrow into the soil feeding on tree roots over the next 17 years.

This whole Cicada phenomenon is so interesting to me. For 17 years, we dongt know that they are in the ground, but then in the 17th year they emerge and take over. While Cicadas are actually a type of grasshopper, many people refer to them as locusts.

With that brief explanation of the Cicada, I want to declare õThe Season of the Locustsö for OTBC. This is something I will be unpacking with you over the next several weeks and even months, but I want to share with you the basic idea here.

Jeremiah 51:14 ó őThe Lord of hosts has sworn by Himself:
Surely I will fill you with a population like locusts,
And they will cry out with shouts of victory over you.ö

Pastor Mark shared with me some weeks ago that a recent survey revealed that the Pfafftown area over to Robinhood Road is the most unchurched area in this whole region. Ever since he shared that with me, I have been burdened and coming before the Lord on what to do. Over these weeks, the Lord has laid on my heart that we, the people of OTBC, are to be a õpopulation like locustsö in our community and go forth with õshouts of victoryö claiming our community for Christ. When locusts move into an area, they move in and take over. They dongt look to the right or to the left, they simply take over. I am challenging all of us to take over our community for Christ.

Now how will we accomplish this? One person, one family, one neighborhood, one workplace, one school, etc. at a time!

We have just completed some outstanding training on prayer walking led by G.L. Brown. Prayer walking is a great way to begin in your own field of harvest.

We have õFamily Fun in the Neighborhoodö coming on June 9th with games, food and the showing of the movie õCourageous.ö Please get free tickets and invite as many unchurched individuals and families as you possibly can. The spiritual health of our community is at stake and we cannot be like Cicadas living underground for 17 years when the spiritual needs around us are urgent.

We will be sharing more ideas for July and August and I welcome ideas you may have of ways that we can penetrate our communities, workplaces, schools, etc. with the life-transforming message of the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Normally, I would not think it would be a good thing to be locusts, but in this case, I believe God has an incredible task and opportunity for us. In fact, I believe the spiritual health of our community is at stake and we cannot lie dormant. With God empowering and leading us, we will go forth into our community with õshouts of victoryö as we work to make Jesus known for the glory of His Name.
