



**Prince of Peace Lutheran Church  
Martinsville, IN**

The Prince of Peace Lutheran Church contacted Omega to bid on a post and beam style structure designed by another architectural firm. The church had received other bids from local builders that exceeded the church budget. Omega suggested several design changes, including the use of a conventional wood-frame structure, and alternate designs for the foundation system and retaining walls.
