



The Lighthouse Church Alsip, IL

Rev. Dan Willis and his ministry leaders have selected Omega to design a signature church on I-294 in Chicago to serve this growing congregation and to provide a suitable home for the 'Pentecostals of Chicago' choir.

The new sanctuary will seat over 1200 on the main floor and 700 in the balcony and is designed for music, multi-media and drama. The 50,000 s.f. addition to the existing 15,000 s.f. church includes classrooms, bookstore, hospitality suite, offices, full-court gymnasium with 150 spectator seats, spacious foyers, and a commercial kitchen. A large prayer room behind the platform will also serve as choir and drama preparation staging. The angel wings supporting and surrounding the structure remind us of the supernatural power that undergirds, protects, and leads the church.
