# ANNUAL REPORT

## LETTER FROM OUR BOARD CHAIR CHANDLER W. RILEY

This past year at Open Door Community House has been an incredibly exciting time. Everyone involved at Open Door, from the board members to the staff, worked hard on developing long term strategies and goals. In doing so, Open Door developed a new mission statement, new core value statements, and a new vision statement. The new mission of Open Door is “to empower impoverished people in our community to realize their full potential as children of God.” We hope that by working toward this mission, we will achieve our vision statement, which is “to eliminate poverty in our community.”



I know what some of you might be thinking, “There is no way you can totally eliminate poverty in our community.” Well, we did not want to set our goal toward something that could be done in a day or two. In fact, during the board’s strategic planning sessions during this past year, we said we wanted to come up with a vision statement that represented a “big, hairy audacious goal.” I think just about everyone would agree that the goal of eliminating poverty in our community is a very audacious goal. This is something that we at Open Door will work on for many years to come, perhaps decades even. However, we will accomplish many great things along the way.

In order to begin our march toward accomplishing the goal of eliminating poverty, we discussed what strategies and methods would best position Open Door toward achieving that goal. It was decided that providing those we serve with long-term solutions, rather than temporary fixes, would be the best way to permanently move those people out of poverty. For example, Open Door ceased operation of our clothing bank ministry. While this is a worthy cause, we feel that other service provider organizations in the community can better serve this immediate need of the impoverished while Open Door can work toward the above-mentioned long-term goals. Therefore, we renovated the space that was formerly occupied by the clothing ministry to be used by our expanded Open Door Institute. We now have a first rate computer lab in that space. The Institute teaches life skills, culinary arts, computer classes, and soon GED preparation. All of these are tools that Open Door’s clients can use to lead themselves out of a life of poverty.

Perhaps the most exciting new initiative at Open Door this past year is the Circles in Columbus program. This program fits right with our mission of “empowering impoverished people in our community to realize their full potential as children of God.” The Circles program is a community strategy to end poverty one family at a time through intentional relationships built across economic class lines. A “Circle” is

an individual family working to get out of poverty with the assistance of two to four “Allies” from the middle or wealthy economic classes who support the “Circle” in their ongoing efforts to develop emotional, intellectual, financial, and spiritual resources. The ultimate goal for these Circle families is economic self-sufficiency and stability.

We’ve set some big goals here at Open Door, but we wouldn’t be able to even begin working towards these goals without the support of our community. Thank you for your past and continued support, and thank you for your time in reading through our Annual Report.

The board elected to close the clothing ministry in October 2012 to renovate the physical space into the current Open Door Institute, a ministry of work and life skills to help impoverished persons have new tools and resources for living wage employment.

As we continue preparing our Strategic Plan, we are proactively examining each area of ministry ensuring its compliance with this long-term vision, and continuing vital community partnerships that seek to do the same.

I cannot say enough about our volunteers, board and staff! They are actively engaged each day in helping people put the broken pieces of their lives back together and creating a safe space where persons in poverty are able to dream of a new and different future for themselves and their families.

We are excited about what God is doing through the Open Door ministries. We look forward to continuing this journey with you. **Thank you** for sharing of God’s love through your faithful support of Open Door.

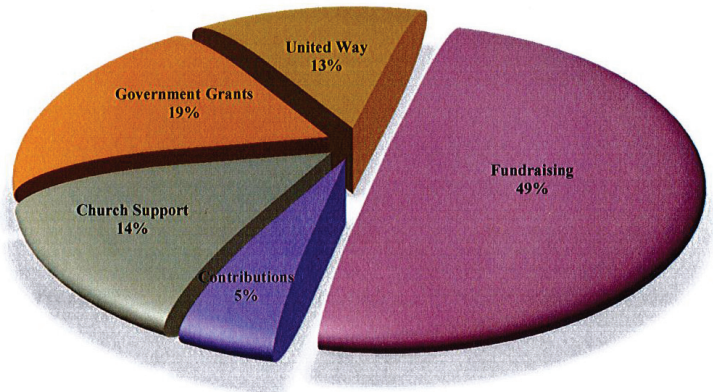

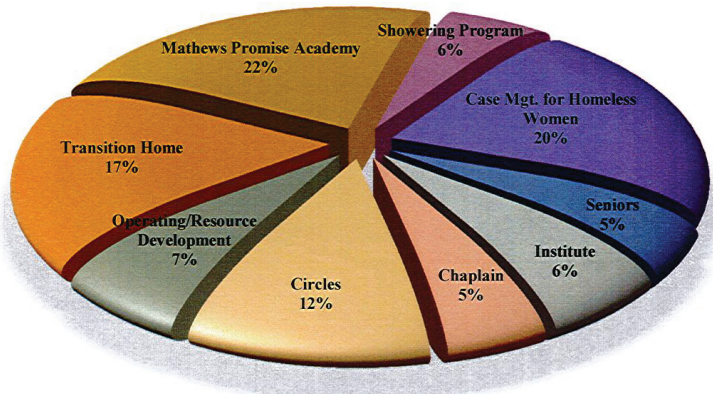

ACTUAL INCOME RECEIVED - \$1,354,916



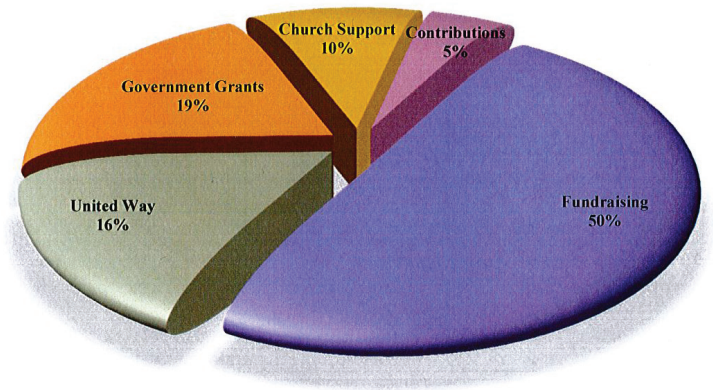
2012-2013

ACTUAL EXPENSES - \$1,241,203



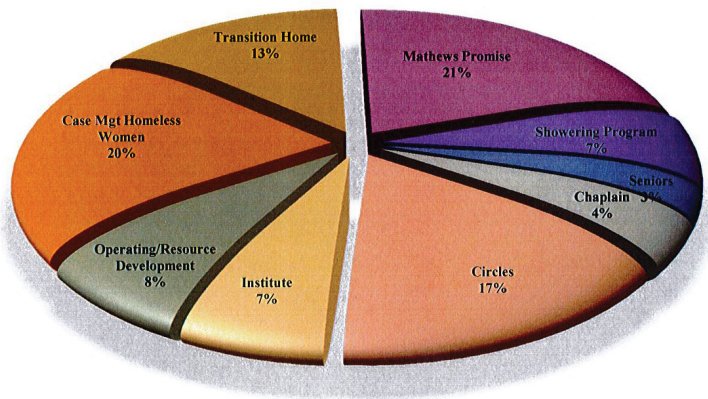
