"Love Is a Verb"

Matthew 25:31-45

Matthew 25:35-36 For I was hungry, and you fed me. I was thirsty, and you gave me a drink. I was a stranger, and you invited me into your home. ³⁶ I was naked, and you gave me clothing. I was sick, and you cared for me. I was in prison, and you visited me.

There are three important ideas from the passage:

- Incarnation, God is here in the messiness and ambiguity of the human life.
- The practice of true religion
- The fundamental truth is that to love is to live.

Most people desire to do "good", but have become tired of helping others due to stress, disappointments or past challenges.

Galatians 6:9 So let's not get tired of doing what is good. At just the right time we will reap a harvest of blessing if we don't give up.
