

Dear OCF Family,

As a member of OCF as well as a member of the Board I am excited about the direction our Church has taken over the past several years. One of the more visible elements was seeing the Mission Impossible campaign become reality. The improvements to our Sanctuary and Foyer are a benefit we experience on a weekly basis. At our recent Town Hall meeting we reviewed the 2014 budget and a newly proposed Capital Campaign. The urgency of this new campaign is probably less visible to most of us as it is more of an infrastructure need. Nevertheless, our staff utilizes the office facility daily, meetings are conducted here and a number of events are held in this space as well. The building, originally constructed as a home, does not perform well for the purposes intended by our church. It is quite dated, a bit in disrepair and certainly not the image we would want to present to visitors. Please take the opportunity to visit our website and also chat with any of the Staff or Board members of OCF to gain a full understanding of why improvements to this facility have become a pressing need. The other portion of the Capital Campaign is for larger maintenance needs that are not budgeted on an annual basis. The most significant of these repairs is to our parking lot, which if left untended could quickly escalate to a much larger expense.

I would ask that you all prayerfully consider your support of this project, which will be voted on from now until December 8th at which time the decision will have been made by the Congregation. If approved, we anticipate gathering additional information over the next couple of months to be followed by a Pledge date in the first quarter. We would then embark on a two-year multi-phase project plan. Though somewhat smaller in scope, this is a very similar format to the previous Mission Impossible Campaign.

It is exciting to see God at work in the lives of those attending OCF and the future direction he has planned for our Church.
