Christmas Reminds Us Whose We Are I Corinthians 1:3-9

I want to remind us all this morning, whose we are.

How many times is Jesus referred to in this passage?

Jesus is the center of who we are.

If Jesus is my center, than my life rotates around Him. I have one boss. His name is Jesus.

Is your life more a Silo or a Wheel?

What likes to take over in your life and take Jesus' place?

What does that look like?

We Belong to Jesus

We forget who we belong to. We belong to Jesus... we don't belong to our work, our spouse, or anyone else. They do not define us. Who defines us?

How strong is the claim that Jesus has on us? (Romans 8:38-39)

Even when we are faithless, God is faithful to us

Have you been faithless?

Jesus is always, always faithful towards us. He is a man of His word. (I Thessalonians 5:23-24)

God wants us as His partner

Lighting Advent Wreath
