“Have you forgotten what the prophets wrote about the one God would send?” the man asked. Then he taught them about the prophets, beginning with Moses.

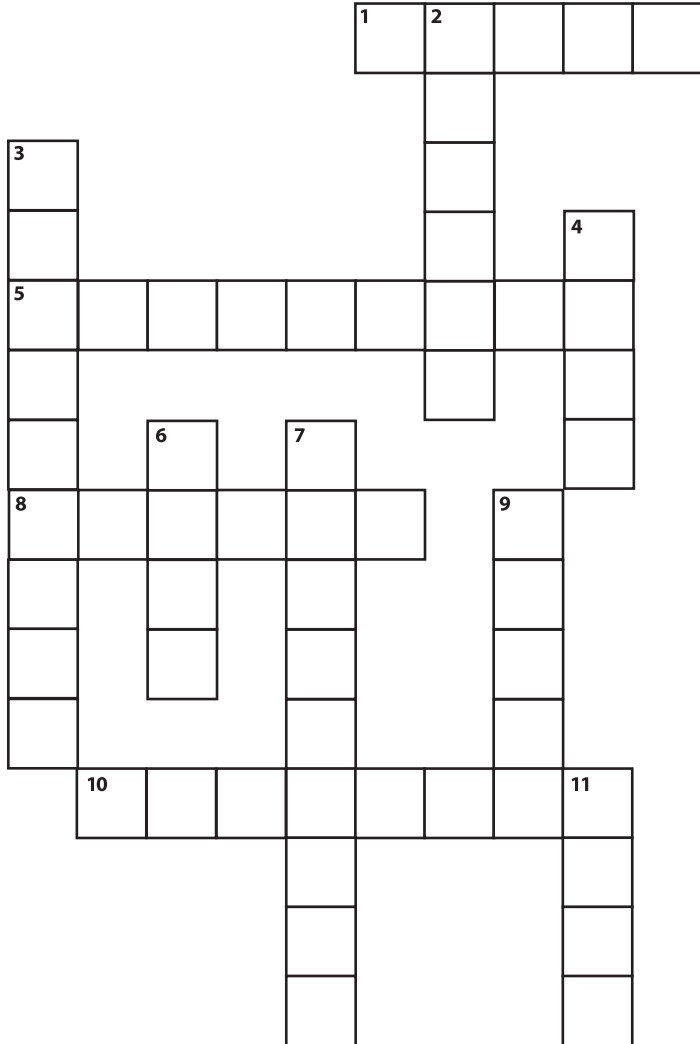
When they got to Emmaus, the two disciples said, “It’s getting dark. Stay with us.”
