## From Palm Sunday to Good Friday

based on Mark 11:1-11; 15:1-39

Adults and children were gathering in the city of Jerusalem to celebrate the Passover. They crowded together, waved palms, and cheered as they caught a glimpse of a man riding on a young donkey. It was Jesus!

That week, Jesus taught many people in the temple about the kingdom of God, and said it would be coming soon. After he ate the Passover meal with his disciples, Jesus was arrested by Roman soldiers. He was put on trial by some of the religious leaders and the Roman governor. The governor offered to release Jesus, but the crowd of people shouted, "Crucify Jesus! Crucify him!"

Some soldiers beat Jesus and made him carry a heavy wooden cross to a place outside the city. There they hung Jesus on the cross. Jesus called out to God in prayer, and then he died.
