

Go! Tell the Good News!

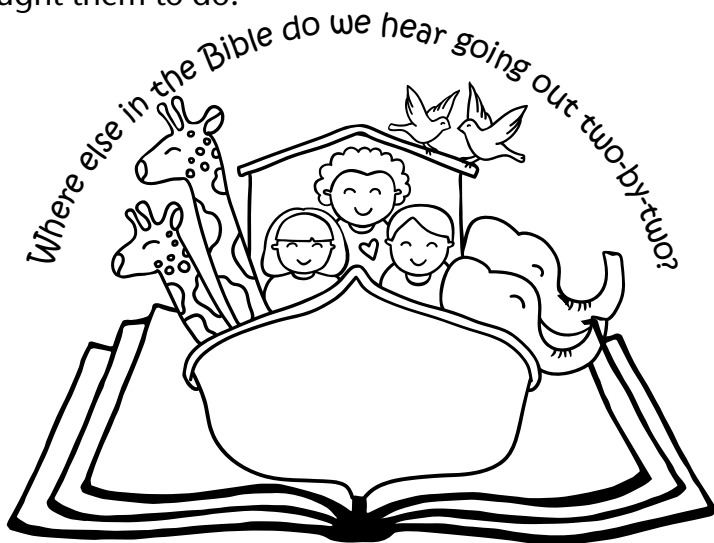
based on Mark 6:1-13
