

## The First Christians Share What They Have based on Acts 4:32-35

After Jesus' death and resurrection, the disciples traveled all around Jerusalem, teaching about God's love and healing people, just as Jesus did. The group of Jesus' followers grew quickly. These early Christians met to worship God. They went to each other's homes to eat, learn, and pray together.

The book of Acts tells what life was like for these first Christians:

*The group of followers all felt the same way about everything. None of them claimed that their possessions were their own, and they shared everything they had with each other. In a powerful way the apostles told everyone that the Lord Jesus was now alive. God greatly blessed his followers, and no one went in need of anything. Everyone who owned land or houses would sell them and bring the money to the apostles. Then they would give the money to anyone who needed it (Acts 4:32-35, Contemporary English Version).*
