Preparing the Way

On our regular calendar, Christmas is at the end of the year. But on the Christian calendar, the First Sunday of Advent is the beginning of the year. We start our year getting ready for Christmas. We get ready for Jesus to come into our lives in a new way for the coming year.

So, how do we get our hearts ready? In ancient times, when the King would visit a city, that city would get ready by fixing up all the roads into the city, so the king would have a smooth journey.

Have you ever watched road construction? Have you ever been stuck in a car waiting for the stop-sign person to let you through? Why does it take so long to repave the road?

They have to level out the ground. Some places are too high, and they have to bulldoze them lower. Some places are too low and they have to fill them in. Some places have wires or water, gas, or sewer pipes that need manholes. If they don't level the ground first, the new pavement will crumble up worse than before.

Read Psalm 85:10-13

Wait! Do the words in these verses seem familiar?
Look up Galatians 5:22-23!

Friday

Read 2 Peter 3:8-15

These talk about Jesus coming again. What does Peter say about why Jesus is taking so long to return?

How are we supposed to live while we wait for Him?

Memory Verse: Mark 1:8
