To Know God Who Give Us New Hearts

It's hard to always be good all the time. Do you always get your homework done before playing video games or going outside with your friends? Do you ever fib? Do you ever stall or ignore your mom or dad when they tell you to do a chore you don't want to do?

Two weeks ago we talked about the Ten Commandments that tell us to not lie and to obey our parents. Last week we also looked at how even little things like complaining can lead us away from God.

So how do we live up to God's standard? It is pretty high.

Jesus did it. He was obedient even when that meant going to the cross. Because of that He is now our High Priest. He prays for us all the time. When we mess up God responds with forgiveness when we repent.
