A Story About a Wedding Feast

Jesus is pretty cool. God is amazing. He created us. He loves us. Even when we aren't perfect, He wants us as a part of His family. He called us to join Him on an amazing adventure to save our world.

So, why do so many people not like God? Why do they not care about Jesus? God extends His invitation to everyone. God wants everyone to ultimately live with Him in heaven.

But there are a lot of people who don't care. They think they've got more important things to

do. There are people who even get angry and violent with God's people. And there are people who kind of like being a part of God's celebration, but not enough to really let Him change them.

We're going to meet people like these in Jesus' parable about a Great Feast. But, also pay attention to the other passages, too. Problem people shouldn't get us down, or make us afraid, but make us pray. Never stop inviting the people around you to God's Great Celebration!

What was wrong with the guy who didn't wear his nice suit to the wedding?</p>	<p><u>Tuesday</u></p> <p>Read Isaiah 25:1-9</p> <p>Hey! This passage is about God throwing a wonderful feast! Who does God invite? What will God do at this feast?</p>
<p><u>Wednesday</u></p> <p>Read Psalm 23</p> <p>Make a Psalm 23 poster to put up in your house.</p> <p>Bonus: can you memorize all 6 verses? Tell your Sunday School teacher next week!</p>	<p><u>Thursday</u></p> <p>Read Philippians 4:1-7</p> <p>Is there anything you are worried about? What does God say to do about that? Have you ever wondered how to pray? Your memory verse is God's instructions for prayer.</p>	<p><u>Friday</u></p> <p>Read Philippians 4:8-9</p> <p>Mind check! What are you thinking about? Is it true, honorable, right, pure, lovely, and admirable? Is it excellent and worthy of praise?</p>
