1 Corinthians

1:3-9

Howdy, Partner!

Did you ever notice that each week we read a passage from the Old Testament, the Psalms, the Gospels, and the Epistles? The passages we will read this week from the Old Testament, the Psalms, the Gospels, and the Epistles all talk about waiting and watching for God to act. But God doesn't want us to just sit and wait. He sent Jesus on a mission to rescue the world from sin and the power of Satan. And God invites you to be a partner in that mission! Jesus is forming a team and He wants YOU on it!

Do you think you're up to joining Jesus' elite team of agents? If you don't think you are, then look at the bottom of this page and memorize that Bible verse! God made you special. You have your own talents (remember Sunday School last week) and skills. God built them into you (and He is an amazing maker).

One more thing: if God wants you to be Jesus' partner, and me to be Jesus' partner, then we are partners together. We call that "Church".

<p><u>Sunday</u></p> <p>Read Isaiah 64:1-9</p> <p>If God "burst from the heavens and came down" what kinds of awesome things do you think He would do?</p>	<p><u>Monday</u></p> <p>Read Mark 13:24-37</p> <p>If you know something really good is going to happen, but you don't know when, how do you wait?</p>	<p><u>Tuesday</u></p> <p>Read Isaiah 64:1-9</p> <p>Play-doh night! Pull out the play-doh (or make some play clay—you can find recipes on-line). As you sculpt things, talk about how God has shaped you.</p>
<p><u>Wednesday</u></p> <p>Read Psalm 80:1-7, 17-19</p> <p>Three times in this psalm the writer says, "Turn us again to Yourself." Which direction are you facing? Three times he also says, "make Your face shine down upon us." What does that mean?</p>	<p><u>Thursday</u></p> <p>Read 1 Corinthians 1:3-9</p> <p>How many times can you count Jesus and/or Christ in these seven verses? What do you learn about Jesus?</p>	<p><u>Friday</u></p> <p>Read 1 Corinthians 1:3-9</p> <p>Sunday is the beginning of Advent Season. We remember when Jesus came to earth as a baby in Bethlehem, and we look forward to when He will come again. Are you excited?</p>
