God Still Calls Us to Remember

Christmas was only four weeks ago. It already seems like a lot longer. The ancient Israelites had three holidays: the Feast of Unleavened Bread, the Feast of Weeks, and the Feast of Tents. They were constant reminders.

Passover called them to remember how awful slavery in Egypt had been and that God had miraculously rescued them. The Feast of Weeks in early summer reminded them, right before they started picking the earliest fruit, that the coming harvest was a blessing from God.

The Feast of Tents (kind of their thanksgiving) reminded them of their journey through the desert when God led them and gave them manna to eat and water to drink. Everybody would camp out in a tent or booth on their rooftop or back yard.

You can tell a lot about someone by what they do. God wants us to look at what He has done so we can learn more about Him. And learn how He calls us to live, too.

Bonus question: Why did Jesus tell the demon to shut up, even though it was telling the truth?</p>
