Mark 16:1-8

To Know The Risen Savior

Jesus did a lot of amazing things. He healed sick people. He fed thousands of people with one boy's lunch. He walked across the Sea of Galilee. He said amazing things about loving your neighbor, and even loving your enemies. He taught us how much God loves us, even though we've often rejected Him, and wants to make us His children. Jesus could say and do such amazing things because Jesus was more than just a human.

But the most important things Jesus said and did took place the day before His death. And the most important thing He did was die on the cross and rise again on that first Easter. For one thing, they prove His claim that He and His Father are God. Secondly, his death and resurrection are the way we can become God's children, washed clean of our sin and shame.

Read Psalm 118:14-24

Thursday

Read Mark 14:17-26

Today is called "Maundy Thursday" celebrating the very first communion. What happened at that dinner?

Friday

Read Mark 15:24-39

Today is called "Good Friday".

This is when we remember
Jesus' suffering on the cross for
our sins. But don't be sad! This
Friday is "good", because
Easter Sunday is coming!

Read Mark 16:1-8

Jesus died.
But He didn't stay dead.
At Easter Service, tomorrow,
remember when someone says,
"He is risen," you say, "He is
risen, indeed!"

Memory Verse: 1 Corinthians 15:3-4
