Learning by Doing

What do you want to be when you grow up?

Some people seem to know when they're very young. Most people don't figure it out until they're a lot older. These days, many people try four or five completely different jobs in their lives.

Peter was a fisherman. Do you think he planned on becoming Jesus' disciple?

Jesus' disciples weren't anybody special. There were fishermen. There was a zealot (a political radical who hated Rome and especially tax collectors) and a tax collector (who hated

zealots). But Jesus brought them all into His group of disciples. It didn't just change their lives; it changed the world forever.

A disciple is a person who wants to learn to be like his teacher. But Jesus' disciples didn't just spend all their time learning how Jesus acted and taught and loved. Jesus started sending them out in teams to teach and heal the sick just like He did.
