## Sermon Outline:

**"Expect Resistance When You Do Justice"**  
**Mark 3:20-22**

**What did Jesus do that stirred up His family and the religious authorities of the day?**

**Jesus was simply following His mission.** Luke 4:18-21

Jesus' mission was to restore to human beings the dignity and worth that we were originally created to have. The Bible has a word for the action of treating human beings with dignity and worth. Justice.

**Jesus willingly disadvantaged Himself for the advantage of the vulnerable around Him.**

**This stirred people up.**

His own family  
Jesus was crazy.

The religious authorities  
Jesus was a devil.

**What is our response to this; that Jesus would disadvantage Himself for the advantage of the vulnerable?**

**1. Will you say to Jesus "I Am Vulnerable"?** Psalm 51:16-17

**2. Will you follow Jesus in doing justice by willingly disadvantaging yourself for the advantage of the vulnerable among us?**

And who are those vulnerable?

**Will you ask God to lay on your heart, open your eyes, to the vulnerable that He wants you to disadvantage yourself for?**
