

# Camp Rules and Packing List

We have five simple rules that we all live by at Camp Cedar Crest to make sure that camps are fun, safe and a great experience for everyone!

**1. Be where you're supposed to be when you're supposed to be there.**

All meals, meetings and activities. Campers must stay within the camp boundaries at all times.

**2. Respect other people and their belongings.**

Fighting, hazing, harassing or using foul language is NEVER permitted. Campers are automatically sent home for stealing or "raiding" (raiding is disrupting or damaging someone's cabin or belongings).

**3. No illegal stuff.**

All articles listed in the "Leave at Home" section must **NOT** be brought to camp!

**4. No guys in or around girls' cabins and no girls in or around guys' cabins.**

**5. You break it you bought it.**

All damages to camp property must be paid for prior to leaving camp. Camp Cedar Crest imposes a \$500 fine for graffiti.

These rules are important and we take them seriously! Anyone who breaks them may be sent home early from camp. Young Adults and/or churches are responsible for the transportation of young adults who are sent home.

## Be Sure to Bring to Camp

- Bible & notebook & pens
- Sleeping bag (put in a plastic bag and label with your name, your church name) & pillow
- Proper clothes for 3 days & 2 nights. Snow clothes.
- Toiletries (toothbrush, shampoo, deodorant, etc.)
- Towels and washcloths
- Chapstick / lip balm
- Flashlight
- Spending money (for snack shop)
- Sun screen
- Refillable Water Bottle (USE IT)
- Dehydration is the #1 sickness at camp!

## Be Sure to Leave at Home

- Alcohol & drugs
- Weapons of any kind
- Fireworks
