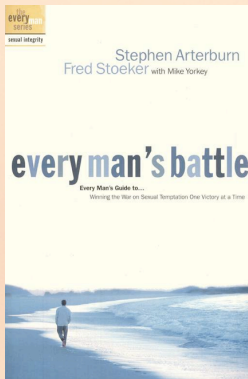

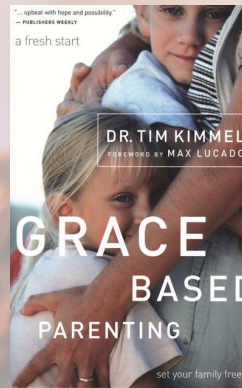

We may not want to admit it, but men are tempted all the time. This is a great "how to" book in overcoming sexual temptation.

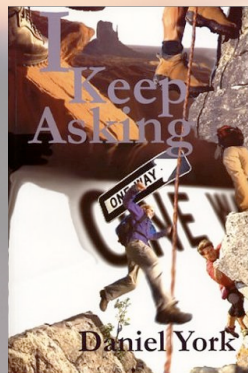
