A MEMORIAL SERVICE honoring the life of Howard O. Hardcastle, father of retired PUC faculty members Rodney Hardcastle and Rosemary Collins, will be held in Scales Chapel at 4 pm today, July 14. A meal will be served in the Fireside Room following the service. Howard served as an Adventist academy English and Spanish teacher and principal. He also served as a Pacific Union College professor of English and associate academic dean. In his retirement, he volunteered at PUC Elementary and St. Helena Hospital. He is survived by a sister and a brother, three children, seven grandchildren, and six great-grandchildren. Howard went to sleep in Jesus on Thursday, June 21, 2018 at the age of 90.

A MEMORIAL SERVICE for Donna Jacobs will be held next Sabbath, July 21, at 4 pm in Scales Chapel. Donna Jacobs, beloved mother and grandma, died in her sleep on June 20, 2018 at age 95. She had a career as a secretary for the Seventh-day Adventist Church, serving in Utah, Illinois, and California. She is survived by daughter Marie Carlton; grandchildren Scott, Becky, Bear, and Christi; and great-grandsons Cyrus and Daniel Dice.
