He also served as a Pacific Union College professor of English and associate academic dean. In his retirement, he volunteered at PUC Elementary and St. Helena Hospital. He is survived by a sister and a brother, three children, seven grandchildren, and six greatgrandchildren. Howard went to sleep in Jesus on Thursday, June 21, 2018 at the age of 90.

A MEMORIAL SERVICE for Donna Jacobs will be held next Sabbath, July 21, at 4 pm in Scales Chapel. Donna Jacobs, beloved mother and grandma, died in her sleep on June 20, 2018 at age 95.
