



Dear Friends,

This Easter season, I have been thinking about the resurrection of Jesus and what it means for us 2000 years later. Additionally, I've been considering the evidence for Jesus' resurrection having happened. We don't have any eyewitness accounts in the Scriptures of Jesus' actual rising from the dead. But we do have the empty tomb, the testimony of the women who encountered the angel there, and the apostle's accounts of the Risen Jesus appearing to them. Of all the post-Resurrection stories, I think the one from today's gospel is the one I love the most: the barbecue on the beach after an eleventh-hour reprieve from a night's fishing that yielded nothing, and the opportunity for Peter to repent of his threefold denial by declaring his love for the Lord three timesⁱ.



The instructions (feed my lambs) that follow Peter's expressions of love are meant for us, too, and that leads me to what I think may be the most convincing evidence for Jesus' resurrection: the vibrant, loving Church, of which we are all a part, still ministering today, feeding the Lord's lambs, with the help of the Holy Spirit.

Still, one cannot deny that there is evil in the world, even within the Church, and that can be discouraging, perhaps obscuring the truth of the Church as the Risen Christ's Body. The fourth verse of Bob Hurd's "Two Were Bound for Emmaus" that we are singing at liturgy today may be helpful:

When the road makes us weary, when our labor seems but loss,
when the fire of faith weakens and too high seems the cost,
let the Church turn to its risen Lord, who for us bore the cross,
and we'll find our hearts burning at the sound of his voiceⁱⁱ.

How do we turn to the risen Lord? In Scripture, in sacrament, and in service: if we feed his lambs, we will find him.

Siempre Adelante!

Local KofC Councils need to raise \$13,225 to pay for half of the cost of an ultrasound machine that is the final step for the Life Centers of VC to become a fully operational medical clinic. (The Supreme Council will cover the other half.) If you are writing a check, please make it out to "Knights of Columbus" with "Life Centers of VC" on the memo line.

Reflecting on God's Word

When you compare the apostles before and after Jesus' death, you can see that not only did something special happen to Jesus at his resurrection, but a wonderful change took place in the apostles as well. Up until the death of Jesus, the apostles did not come off very well. When the chips were down, they ran.

But after the Lord has risen and appeared to them, we get a very different picture. In the Acts of the Apostles Luke gives us the most detailed description of what went on after the Holy Spirit descended upon this little community praying in the upper room.

The most obvious gift was courage, a word that has the same root as "heart." They were given a new heart. The Holy Spirit breathed new life into them and gave them a heart passionately in love with Christ, on fire to preach the gospel. And so they went to the heart of their city, the temple, and there they preached and taught about Jesus, witnessing to him as the Messiah, the Holy and Righteous One, the Author of Life.

They performed "many signs and wonders" (Acts 5:12), healing the sick and casting out unclean spirits. There they were arrested and taken to prison and beaten, only to return to the temple and do it all again, and be arrested again. Through all this they were joyful.

The philosopher Friedrich Nietzsche is remembered for saying that perhaps he would believe in our redeemer if we Christians looked a little more redeemed. Do you?






