



A Very Blessed Time of Year

For me Lent and Easter are the most meaningful times of our Christian year. We are called upon to make sacrifices realizing that Jesus Christ made the ultimate sacrifice. Our sacrifices are real to us of course. Giving up meat on Fridays and giving up candy or dessert may meet our personal definition of sacrifice and that is a personal thing.

As parishioners we are called upon to make an annual sacrifice also to the Together in Mission fund.

This year we are called upon to raise \$105,400 for our share of the Together in Mission needs. That is our share of the diocese goal of \$15.7 million. Last year we had nearly 600 donors contribute and we were able to reach our parish goal by December. So far we have 300 donors and we hope to double the number of donors in the next few months. Together in Mission is intended to be a five month campaign however Padre Serra continues our campaign until we reach our goal.

You may recall a few weekends ago we welcomed Monsignor Tim Dyer as our presider at all our masses. Father Tim is the pastor of two parishes in East Los Angeles and he shared the challenges his parishes face. It is always enlightening to hear what parishes would not have were it not for Together in Mission. In the case of Father Tim's parishes it is possible they may not keep their doors open at all. The same is true of the other 80 parishes and 63 schools who received Together in Mission funds last year. These 63 schools serve 12,190 students.

I worked in Chicago for several years and the Chicago Diocese did not have a Together in Mission program like Los Angeles. It was heart breaking to hear that another school or church would have to close because it did not have the money to keep its doors open. Often times the decision was made with very short notice and parishioners would come to mass on Sunday to learn the tragic news that their parish is closing. The diocese in Chicago had huge warehouses and they would dispatch moving vans to the closing parishes where they would pack up all the usable hymnals, pews, and other assets to put into storage for distribution to parishes that survived.

Each of us develop an attachment to our parish. Memories of baptisms, confirmations, weddings, funerals and other important memorable events in our lives stay with us forever. Imagine the heart break seeing your parish packed up and hauled to a warehouse and the church building torn down or sold.

Together in Mission helps us to avoid such tragedies in our Diocese. Please reflect on what sacrifice YOU can make to help the Together in Mission campaign. Although I love going to Starbucks I realize that if I skipped a few trips for coffee it could make a difference to poor parishes and schools in our diocese. Join the 83,776 families in

our diocese who made contributions. Envelopes remain available in the church narthex if you are able to make a pledge or can increase a prior pledge or gift.

God bless you for your sacrifices.


Protect the Children
