## Policies and Procedures

### 2016/2017 Season

**Responsibility to be aware of dates and events:** It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian or adult student to be aware of all school activities (such as recitals, extra classes, and the dates the school is opened or closed). The school will include this information in the calendar of events, quarterly SSA newsletter, and will post all such notices on the Surrendered School of the Arts website ([www.surrenderedschool.com](http://www.surrenderedschool.com)). Please regularly check your email and the website for updates for the school. It is also the responsibility of the parent/guardian or adult student to inform the school of any address or telephone change.

**Email Communications:** SSA is going paperless! All communication (such as receipts, reminders for upcoming dates/events, and statements) will be made with SSA families through email. **Please make sure you have selected “send e-mails to family” on your on-line family account in order to receive communication.**

**Registration Fee:** A non-refundable registration fee of \$25.00 per student is required yearly by August 15 or at the time of enrollment in order to confirm your student’s registration. Maximum registration fee per family will not exceed \$55.00.

**Tuition Payments:** SSA charges an *annual* tuition rate based on the 32 week season. The annual fee has been divided into equal, monthly payments. Tuition fees will be the same each month regardless of how many times a class meets. Tuition has already been prorated to adjust for holidays. All tuition is prorated on a yearly basis from September to May. It is understood that students register with the intention of attending SSA for the entire season. SSA will not give refunds on prior tuition payments if a student/family decides to drop classes.

**Tuition is due by the 5th of each month:** Each month’s tuition fee is due by the 5<sup>th</sup> of the month with the exception of the first month’s tuition, which is due by the first day of classes. SSA will implement a \$10.00 late fee on all late payments. All returned checks will incur a \$40 fee. If tuition is late 60 days or more, the parent/guardian must meet with the directors to discuss the account. If no communication with the directors has been made, the account will be suspended and the student will be dropped from class. Accounts must be balanced at \$0.00 in order to purchase recital tickets, order photos, order recital DVDs, and register for new classes or seasons. Automatic tuition withdrawal is available upon request and accounts will be charged on the 5<sup>th</sup> of each month for *any* remaining balance due. It is the

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responsibility of the parent, guardian, or adult student to notify SSA of any changes in home address or credit card information (such as expiration dates).

**Tuition Discounts:** SSA is happy to offer Students/Families enrolled in two or more classes a 10% discount on total tuition due. Ballet 5 and 6 students will be eligible for a flat rate tuition fee when enrolling in multiple classes. An additional 10% discount on tuition for students of active military families is also available. Families with 3 or more students can inquire about additional discounts!

**Withdrawal and Refunds:** The month of September is non-refundable. There will be no refunds for missed classes. We ask that one enrolls with the intention of completing the season, but if it is decided to withdraw, it must be done in writing in person at the front office or via email at [admin@surrenderedschool.com](mailto:admin@surrenderedschool.com). If the withdrawal is submitted within the first 7 days of the month, no charge will be issued for that month; however, if submitted after the first 7 days, that month's tuition will be forfeited. Please be aware that if, at any time, a class falls below the minimum of 6 registered students it is in jeopardy of being canceled.

**Class Minimum:** SSA classes require a minimum of 6 registered students in order to begin and continue. Classes that fail to reach the minimum will be put "on hold." All tuition monies will be put "on hold" as well, until the class resumes. Families will be notified at least 24 hours prior to the start of class if the class is canceled. Please be aware that if, at any time, a class falls below the minimum of 6 registered students it is in jeopardy of being canceled.

**Information about your child:** SSA staff requests that you fill out a Student Information Form upon enrollment. Please visit our administrator to give us any information that you would like us to know about your child that may affect their class time, including allergies/special needs/learning disabilities/privacy related issues etc. We will take note of this information in their online file and make sure all staff is notified. All enrolled students must have a Student Information Form on file.

**Extreme weather or unexpected interruption of classes:** If the school must cancel classes due to extreme weather or events beyond our control, these missed lessons will not be re-funded, however, there will be opportunities to make up these lessons during the SSA school year. SSA Tacoma Campus will follow the Tacoma School District for all weather related closures. In the event of extreme weather, please visit [www.schoolreport.org](http://www.schoolreport.org) for a list of school closures. Please do not contact SSA. SSA will make every attempt to notify families of closures via email, phone, and/or Facebook.

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**Dress Code/Supplies for classes:** Students will be expected to follow the dress code as received upon enrollment. The dress code will be enforced; however families will be given a 3 week grace period so items can be purchased. Students/families are responsible for purchasing dress code items. SSA will provide each student/family with a list of required items to be purchased. (This also includes information on appropriate hair styles for dance classes).

SSA recommends purchasing items through [www.discountdance.com](http://www.discountdance.com). Items listed should be purchased by brand name and style number listed to insure the color and style quality SSA requires.

Supplies or lessons needed for classes (as necessary) will be communicated to the students/families upon enrollment or through the teacher. Parents will be given ample time to acquire items necessary for classes.

**Ballet Shoe Fit:** In order to ensure proper fit, your ballet teacher will adjust and trim the drawstrings on your student's ballet shoes. The drawstrings are not supposed to be long enough to tie into a bow. Your ballet instructor has extensive experience trimming ballet shoe drawstrings and will be happy to answer any questions about the proper fit of ballet shoes, **please make sure your child does not play with or remove the knot after your instructor has adjusted the shoes!**

**Substitutions:** Many of the SSA ballet classes are going to be dual taught this year by two talented teachers who understand and agree with the heart and mission of the school. We are blessed to have these classes taught by both professional dancers from our parent ministry, Paradosi Ballet Company, and experienced teachers whose passion is to teach the next generation a love for worshipping in dance. We are excited to have this opportunity for students to learn from two different teachers on a regular basis throughout the season.

The classes not having two scheduled teachers will have a weekly teacher as well as a qualified substitute assigned who will teach in the event of the teacher having to miss a class period. The substitute will work closely with the teacher and step in as needed. This will keep the class on track during the teacher's absence.

**Photo Release:** The school is hereby granted permission to take photographs/video of the students to use in brochures, websites, posters, advertisements, social media, and other promotional materials the school creates. Permission is also hereby granted for the school to copyright such photographs/video in its name.

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**SSA Yearly Recitals:** SSA has one recital for the 2016/2017 season. The Spring Recital is tentatively scheduled for June 3. Location will be determined. The Spring recital has a **non-refundable** performance fee of \$25 per student due March 15) This fee is used to offset the cost of the recital. The recital performance fee is used for the following: The replenishment of costume pieces which SSA students borrow as well as alterations to these pieces; the cost of securing the venue which helps us keep ticket prices low; the cost of dress rehearsal, the cost of printing and other fees associated with recital. The Spring Recital date and location will be confirmed and shared with families by March 1. Detailed recital information including recital assignments, costumes, tickets, etc. will also be available by March 15.

This year, Surrendered School of the Arts will be presenting a Christmas Ballet, "The Gift," (potential dates are December 19-22) rather than holding a Christmas Recital. There will be auditions for the ballet for any student wishing to participate. Auditions for students in levels 3-6 will be **September 17**. Auditions for students in Pre Ballet-Ballet 2 will be **October 1**. These auditions will be to determine roles; all ballet students will be cast. Rehearsals for Pre Ballet students-Ballet 2 will be on Saturdays, and rehearsals for levels 3-6 will be Wednesday evenings. There will be a monthly fee of \$15 to cover the cost of the rehearsal process, and a one time \$50 performance fee. Presenting this ballet and holding rehearsals outside of regularly scheduled class time, instead of having a Christmas recital, will allow teachers to use class time to instruct students in technique rather than using it to rehearse choreography. Insuring that class time remains dedicated to technical instruction will allow students to progress and grow in skill and strength at a much faster rate! Hip Hop students desiring to perform in the program will learn a dance during regularly scheduled class time. There will be a \$25/student performance fee for Hip Hop students.

**Breaks, holidays, important dates:** *September 12* (First day of classes), *September 17* (Upper Division Auditions), *October 1* (Lower Division Auditions), *October 3-8* (Bring A Friend Week), *November 21-26* (Thanksgiving Break), *December 12-17* (Parent Observation Week), *December 19-22* (tentative dates for Christmas Ballet "The Gift"), *December 19-January 7* (Christmas Break), *January 9* (Classes resume), *February 27-March 4* (Bring A Friend Week), *March 1* (Last day to Enroll and participate in Spring Recital), *April 3-8* (All Campus Spring Break), *April 24-29* (Parent Observation), *May 27* (Last day of classes for Orting and Tacoma. After School Enrichment Campuses TBD), *June 3* (Spring Recital).

Parents, legal guardians of minors, students, and adult students waive the right to any legal action for any injury sustained on school property resulting from normal dance activity or any other activity conducted by the students before, during, or after class time.

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**Studio Etiquette Guidelines:** SSA students and families will be expected to follow *Studio Etiquette* to help create a positive learning environment for each student. SSA administration will immediately address any issues pertaining to the Studio Etiquette with parents and students as necessary.

## **Studio Etiquette**

### **2016/2017 Season**

**Arrival:** Please arrive to class on time. We recommend allowing at least 5 minutes before class so students can be lined up and ready to go when their class time begins. All students must line up and wait outside the studio door until they are invited into the class by the teacher. If a student needs to be dropped off more than 30 minutes early, please call to make prior arrangements.

**Attendance:** Regular attendance and prompt arrival to class is necessary in order for classes to advance. If a student is late, we ask that they wait to the side of the classroom until the instructor gives permission to join the class. If a student is more than 15 minutes late to class, he/she may be asked to sit and observe as a precaution to injury. Please call the Main Tacoma Campus or email SSA if a student will be arriving late or absent for any reason. After a student has missed two consecutive weeks without communicating with SSA, they will be in jeopardy of being dropped from the class so another student can take their spot.

**Check in/Drop off:** Teachers will take roll in the studio... please drop your child off at the appropriate classroom.\* Please make sure your child isn't wearing or bringing anything other than what is needed for their class time (no jackets/backpacks/etc.). If desired, you may wait for your child in our lobby. When class is dismissed, students will be released back to parents. Children whose parents are not present at dismissal will be asked to sit on the black bench in the lobby and wait patiently. Parents are asked to call the receptionist if they will not be arriving on time so SSA Staff is aware. SSA Staff cannot be held responsible for students out of class time, with many parents and students leaving and arriving we are not equipped or prepared to supervise children waiting for parents. Thank you for your understanding.

\*Ballet/Tap Combo parents/guardians may not leave facility and must be available to take their child out of class if needed.

\* Dance With Me parents/guardians must be present in the classroom with their student at all times.

**The dress code for each class/level must be worn to all classes, including the appropriate hairstyle.** Each family/student is responsible for purchasing their class uniform. Class uniforms are listed in detail on our *SSA Uniform/Dress Code* and *Uniform Ordering Information* documents. Items listed should be purchased by brand name listed to insure the color and style quality SSA requires. Uniforms may be updated/reordered periodically throughout the year. Necessary supplies that may be needed for classes will be communicated to each family upon enrollment or as the class progresses. Students are expected to be in uniform by their third week of class.



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**Observation:** We understand that being able to observe your children is very important for many of you. We would love to be able to provide this opportunity while maintaining the integrity of the instruction with as little disruption as possible.

-Tacoma Campus: Parents may sit on the side of Studio 3 (as instructed /communicated by teacher) to view their child in class from time to time. Parents may observe classes in Studio 1 through the viewing window (please refrain from touching or tapping on the glass).

-Orting and Gig Harbor Campuses: Parents may sit on the chairs on the side of the room (as instructed /communicated by teacher) to view their child in class from time to time.

We do ask that you not communicate with your child during that time or allow your child to come and sit with you. This causes a disruption to the class and will hinder the learning/growth of the students. We strongly encourage parents to limit their in-studio observation to scheduled Parent Observation Weeks. If concerns or problems arise, teachers/staff will discuss with families/students. Concerns may be addressed directly to School Principal Tabi at [tabi@paradosiballetcompany.com](mailto:tabi@paradosiballetcompany.com) or Administrator Katie Capilla at [admin@surrenderedschool.com](mailto:admin@surrenderedschool.com).

**Restroom:** Students are asked to use the bathroom **BEFORE** class, not during class. If absolutely necessary, students must raise their hand and ask permission to use the restroom prior to leaving. Upon returning, they must wait patiently inside the door for the teacher's permission to join the class again. Students may not leave the studio at any time without asking permission from the instructor first.

**Parents, please accompany younger children to the bathroom.**

**Studio Space:** Please respect SSA and Satellite Campus property and leave it exactly as you found it. Students are also asked to respect the space and items in the space. This means cleaning up after yourselves and not touching things that don't belong to you. Students may not touch the mirrors or hang on the barres in the studios. **Parents and those waiting in the lobby; we kindly ask that you keep your children not participating in classes quiet and respectful of staff space and offices. Please keep an eye on your children at all times, SSA and its' staff are not responsible for children that are not in classes. Also please clean up toys, snacks, books etc that are used during your time here. Thank you for helping us keep our space clean and safe!**

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**Discipline:** If a student has difficulty obeying instruction after continual warning, the instructor may ask the child to sit momentarily and not participate in class activities for a short designated amount of time. In addition, a report card will be sent home with the student as well as emailed to the family. This will be at the instructor's discernment and will be discussed in detail with the parent after class, if possible, or through phone conversation before the next class time. If a student receives three or more report cards, SSA directors will discuss the student's behavior with the family before the student will be allowed to attend future classes.

**Water bottles and personal items:** Students may not bring personal items into class. Items may be left in cubbies/dressing room or with a parent. Water bottles are allowed and encouraged for Hip Hop and Ballet 3-6 and are to be labeled with the student's name and set on the side of the room. Students may not wear jewelry in dance classes besides stud earrings. If a student is wearing jewelry that is not allowed, it will be removed by the teacher and held during class time as a precaution to injury/distraction. Students will receive their items back after class. Also, students may not chew gum in class, or bring food, drinks or electronics into class.

**Respect:** All students are expected to treat their instructors and fellow students with respect at all times and address each teacher or staff member with Miss, Ms., Mrs. or Mr. before their name.
