To accomplish what God has ordered, we need a group of believers who are willing to "Stand in the Gap". Each member of our ministry team has volunteered their time for the past 3 years. With no salary they have worked numerous jobs to pay the bills, believing in faith that the Lord will provide. He has, Praise God! Now, God has impressed upon us that we need to contend for support.

Our dancers spend 25 hours in studio each week: devotions, bible study, evangelism training, ballet classes, choreography, rehearsals, paperwork, meetings, emails etc. We perform 3 weekends each month in addition to the significant administrative jobs that maintaining a company and a school of the arts requires. Needless to say, our team members cannot sustain this output and still have ministry of excellence unto the Lord.

As a Support Partner, we will add your name to our support page on our new website launching mid July.

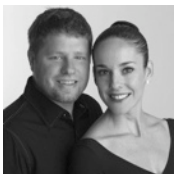
As a Support Partner, you will receive a Paradosi T-shirt and a full color poster of our latest production that has been personally signed by the company.
