From the Administrator's Desk

Christian schools across the country are facing challenging times, especially in light of the economy. Even Parsippany Christian School has not been exempt as we now have approximately 90 less students than just a few years ago. This means around \$350,000 less than we once had to operate when expenses (especially health insurance) are skyrocketing. Consequently, it has become necessary to significantly reduce our expenses by decreasing the number of faculty. It is with regret that we inform you Rick and Kathy Sandifer will not be returning to teach here next fall.

Rick and Kathy Sandifer have served faithfully as teachers at Parsippany Christian School since 1991. Kathy has taught third grade for most of their twenty-one years here. She taught fifth grade for a few years as well, and she has given private piano lessons. Rick has taught high school English, Spanish, Career Education and Speech, and he has headed up the Stanford Achievement Testing as well as college counseling for our senior classes. This year he has helped where needed in the fifth grade in the afternoons.

The Lord has used them for His work not only in the school ministry but also as choir members, in Patch Club for two years, and as Sunday school teachers. We pray that God will bless their future ministries to His glory.
