If you are using your transportation allowance as part of your tuition payments, please be reminded that report cards will be sent home after we receive your check.

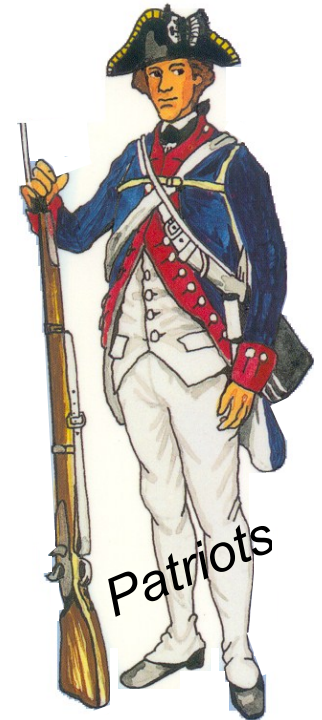

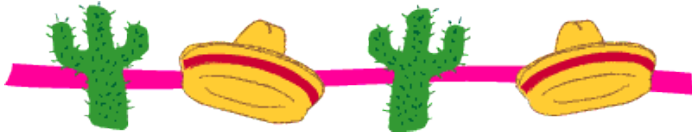
