Watt's Up:

“I Know God Still Speaks!”



Power Verse:

“My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me.”

- **John 10:27**

Say:

Ask:

- How did God speak to you? (*out loud, through your thoughts, etc.*)

Share:
